2. As per the guidelines, the meeting of the Awards Committee for identifying the Awardee Teachers, was held at CIET-NCERT from 23rd to 27th April, 2018. In the meeting, the Awards Committee interacted with the nominated teachers, and thereafter short listed and recommended 43 awardees for the Awards. 3. Further, it is to inform you that the ceremony for giving the National ICT Awards has been scheduled on 21st November, 2018 at Dr. Ambedkar International Centre, 15 Janpath Road, New Delhi. The Award winners may bring only one escort with them. Children below 14 years of age are not allowed. The travel expenses of the escort will also be borne by NCERT as per its norms (II AC train fare only). Accommodation (AC Rooms) for awardees and their escort (only one Escort is permissible) has been arranged in NIE Guest House, NCERT, New Delhi- 110016.

4. Entry to the ceremony venue is restricted to one escort per Awardee. Therefore, the Awardees are requested to mail us the name, address and relationship of the escort within 7 days so as to enable us to take required security clearances etc. Please carry your identity card and identity proof of your escort as well. All the awardees are to report to the NIE-Guest House, NCERT, New Delhi on 19th November, 2018(morning) positively. Further programme details will be made available on your arrival at NIE Guest House, NCERT, New Delhi.
