DIKSHA

- In Telangana, Energizing Text Books has been initiated in 2018-19 with 4 Titles.
- ☐ Till date 92 Text Books of Class 1 to Class 10 has been Energized. In each Text Book for each chapter 2 QR codes are inserted 1 at the start of the chapter and another QR code for assessment.
- □ We empowered our 108 high school non-language teachers (Mathematics, Physical Science, Biological Science & Social Studies) and 310 Primary School teachers by giving online training through webinars/zoom meetings.
- ☐ The training topics are: Installation of Softwares, Creative Commons, PPT & Animations, Video Editing Kdenlive, Audio Editing Audacity
- These trained teachers only developed all the e-content uploaded on DIKSHA is helpful in classroom transactions.

- Learning outcomes slide (should be with voice)
- Hook (Thought provoking questions by showing an image, video, experiment etc.,)
- Explanation about the topic, use daily life examples, mention mistakes and misconceptions if any
- Evaluation questions (should be with voice)
- Content Creator's details slide
- Attributions slide
- Officials and QR codes development team slide

Digital initiative on co curricular activities

- SCERT in collaboration with the Government College of Physical Education, Hyderabad has developed 21 video lessons on Yoga for school children as a part of co-curricular subject for promoting health and wellbeing among the students.

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

Tic Tac Learn Videos

- No. of Videos developed : 10000+ Videos and 875+ Hrs of Content
- Subject:
 - Mathematics for Classes 1 to 10
 - EVS and Science for Classes 3 to 10
- All the Videos are Animated, of High quality and Pedagogically sound (4-5 mins)
- Videos are linked with the School Education Official website.

WhatsApp Chat Bot 'Intinta Chaduvula Panta'

Objective: Weekly assessment of children to help, identify and address learning gaps. Providing asynchronous access to high-quality content and teaching support through WhatsApp to the children.

Procedure:

- WhatsApp Bot No. 8595524405 disseminated to students
- Worksheets designed for classes I to X for all subjects linked with WhatsApp Bot.
- Questions pertaining to two subjects per week can be practiced by students' on the Chat Bot.

WhatsApp Chat Bot 'Intinta Chaduvula Panta'

- After practice, answer key is sent.
- Based on students' answers chat bot sends relevant video links for further learning.
- Reporting (Live dashboard) is linked with School Education Website for DEOs to track their district's usage and review with MEOs and Teachers.
- Helpline no. 011-40747485 is created for technical queries.
- Developed material for WhatsApp Chatbot in collaboration with the Central Square Foundation
- The programme is being implemented in English, Telugu and Urdu Media.

Tele service by Special Educators

- Objective: To provide Tele-service to parents of CWSN during COVID-19 pandemic.
- Initially, all Special Educators (Inclusive Education Resource Persons)
 were trained virtually
- The training inputs include Balancing mental health, Strategies to work with families of CwSN, Behavioural management, Emotional regulation, Remedial Teaching strategies.
- After training, Special Educators have provided tele-service to parents of CwSN who are under School Readiness Programme and Home Based Education.
- Child wise action plan adopted by the Special Educators so as to cover each child at least twice a week and guided parents on how to handle the children and follow up action to be taken for improving their skills.
