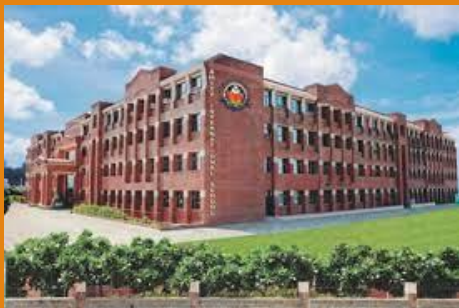


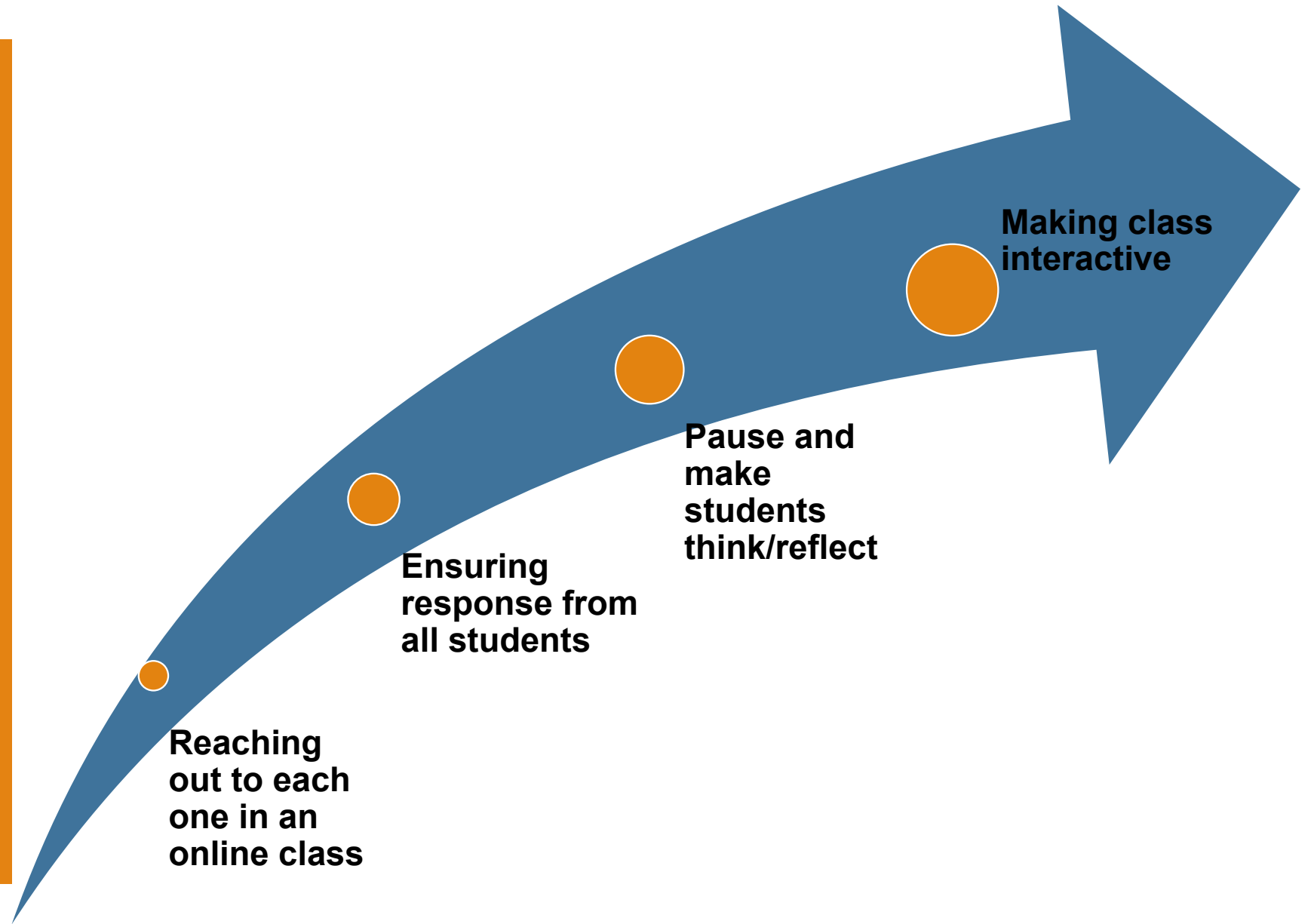

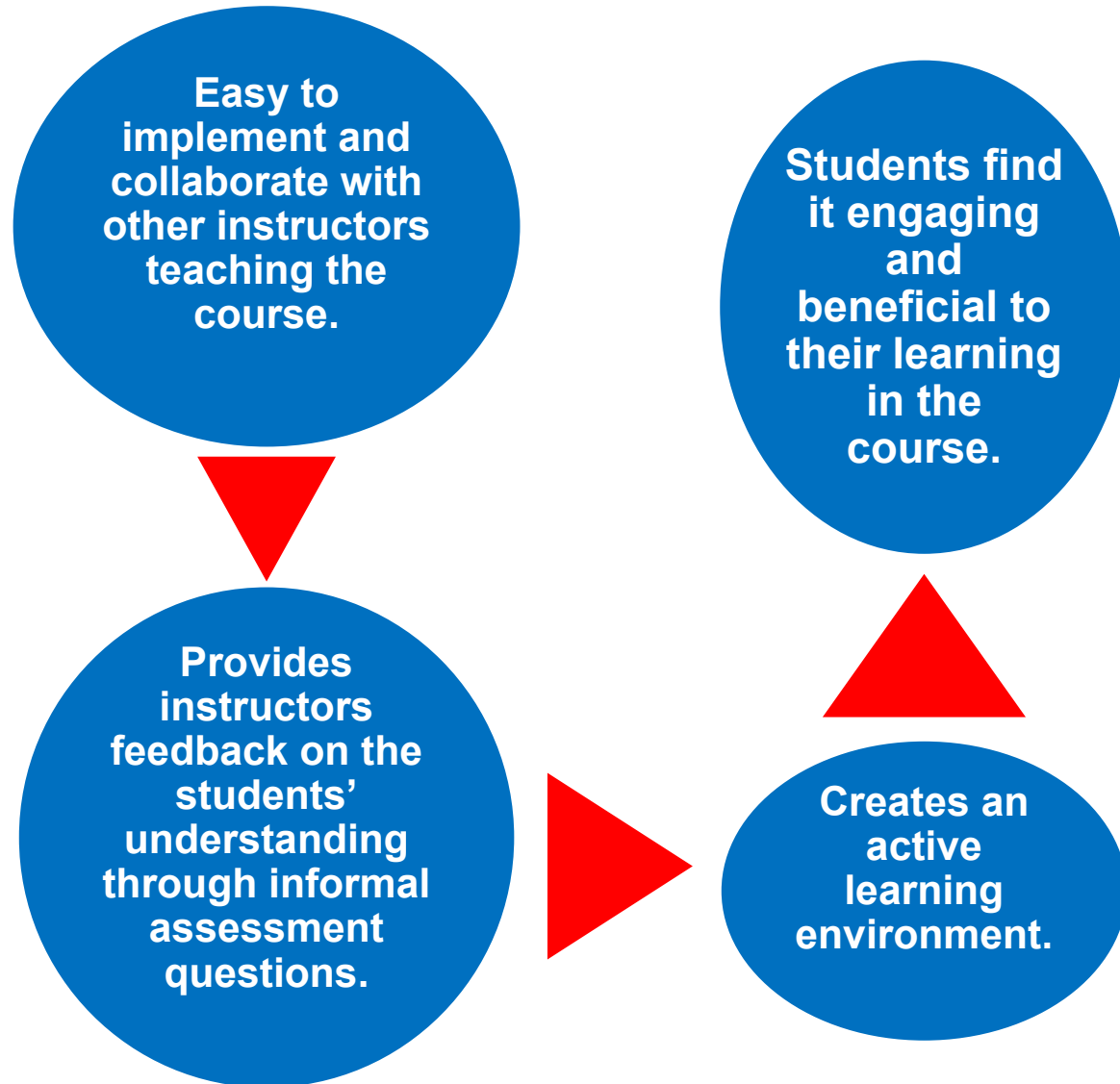


**Pear Deck is a free(basic account) add-on tool in Google/Microsoft Slides that can be used to create interactive and engaging presentations.**

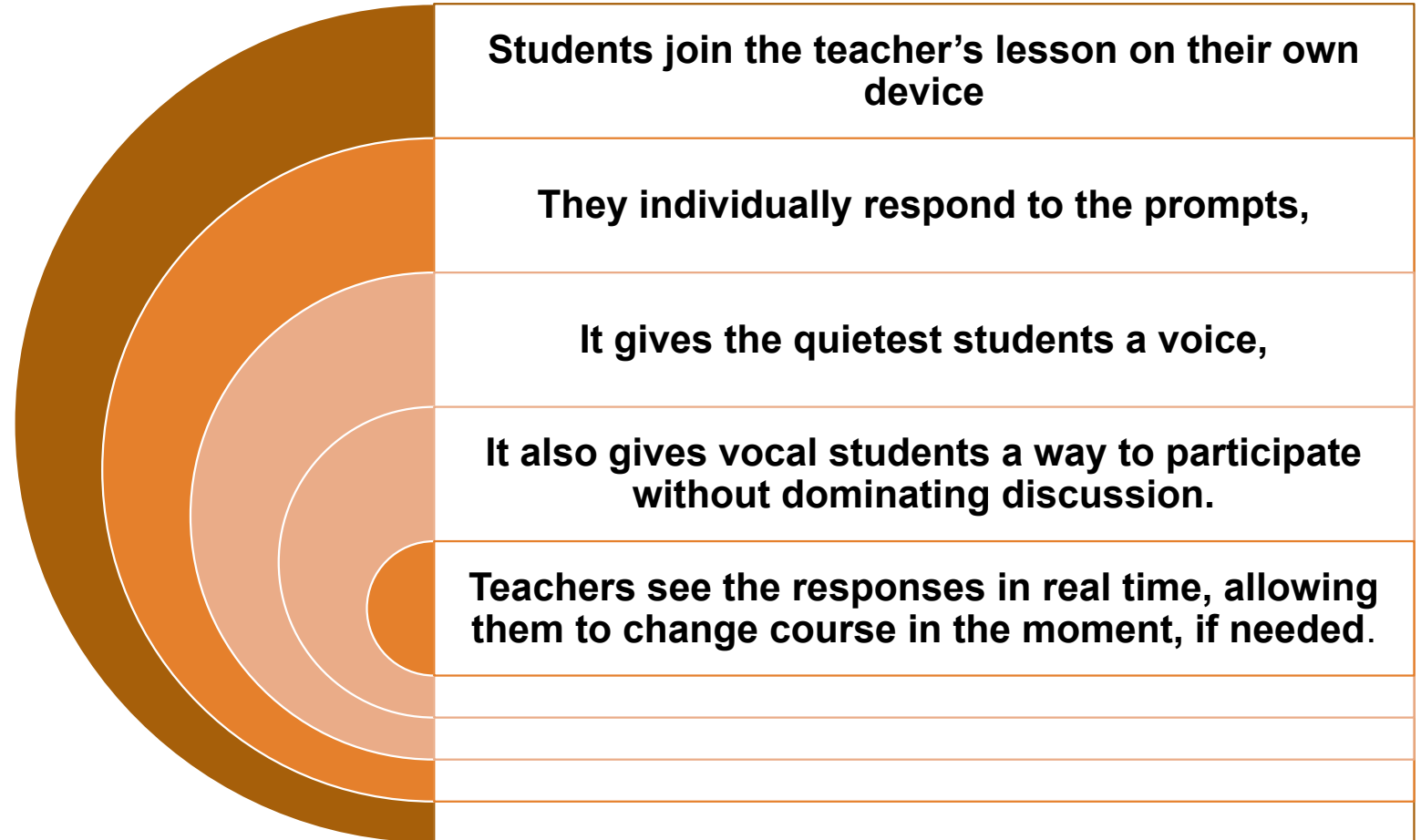


**The interactive feature of Pear Deck allows instructors to develop creative Slide presentations and assess their students' understanding of the material in an informal environment.**

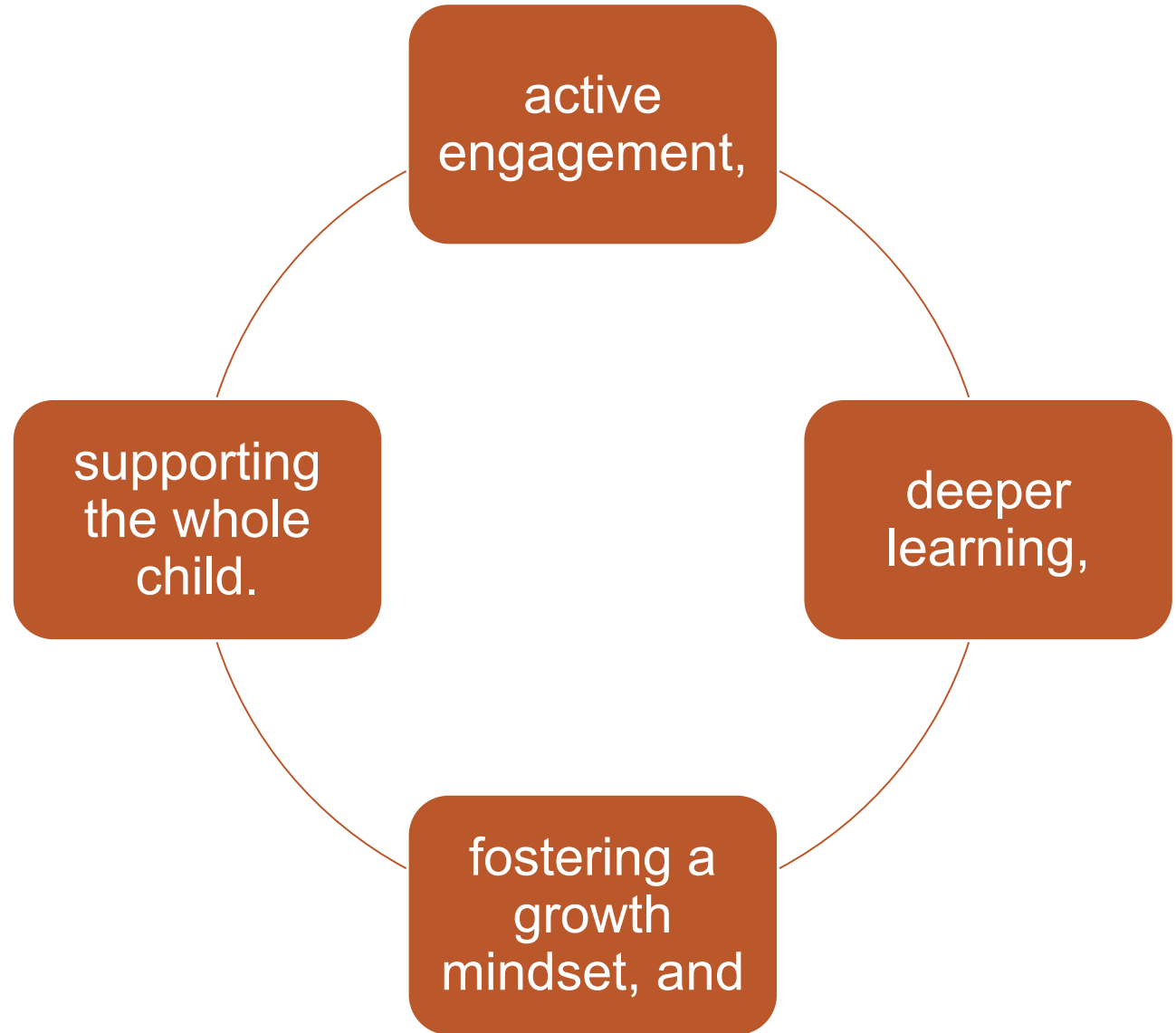
# Why use Pear Deck?

automatically in OneDrive

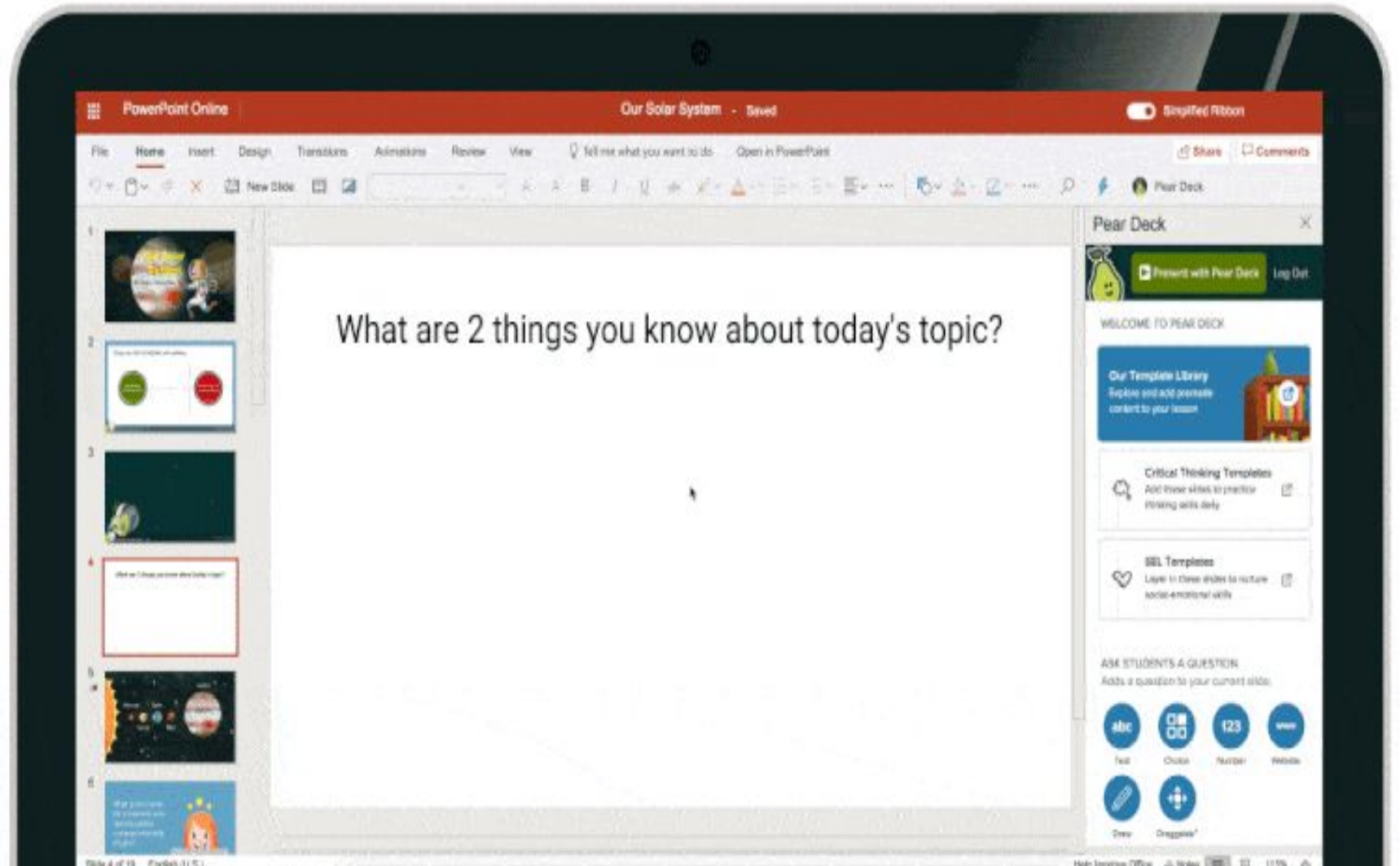
Students sign in with their

through Microsoft Teams also

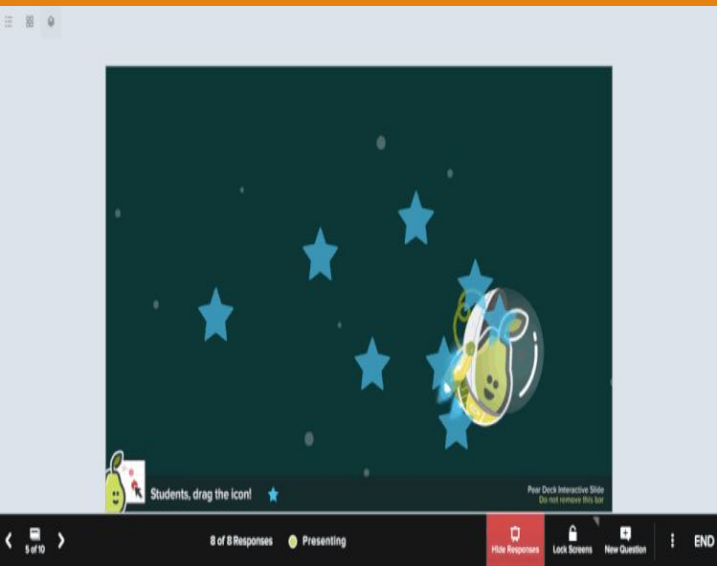


Install the Pear Deck add-in to PowerPoint.

Through the sidebar add interactive questions/pre-made templates to slides.



# How to Create a new Presentation?



To create a new Pear Deck, first log into Pear Deck and click “Create a Presentation.”

This will create a brand new Microsoft PowerPoint file for you. Next install the Pear Deck Add-in, open the Sidebar, and insert slides from our template library.

Install the Pear Deck Add-in and open the Sidebar

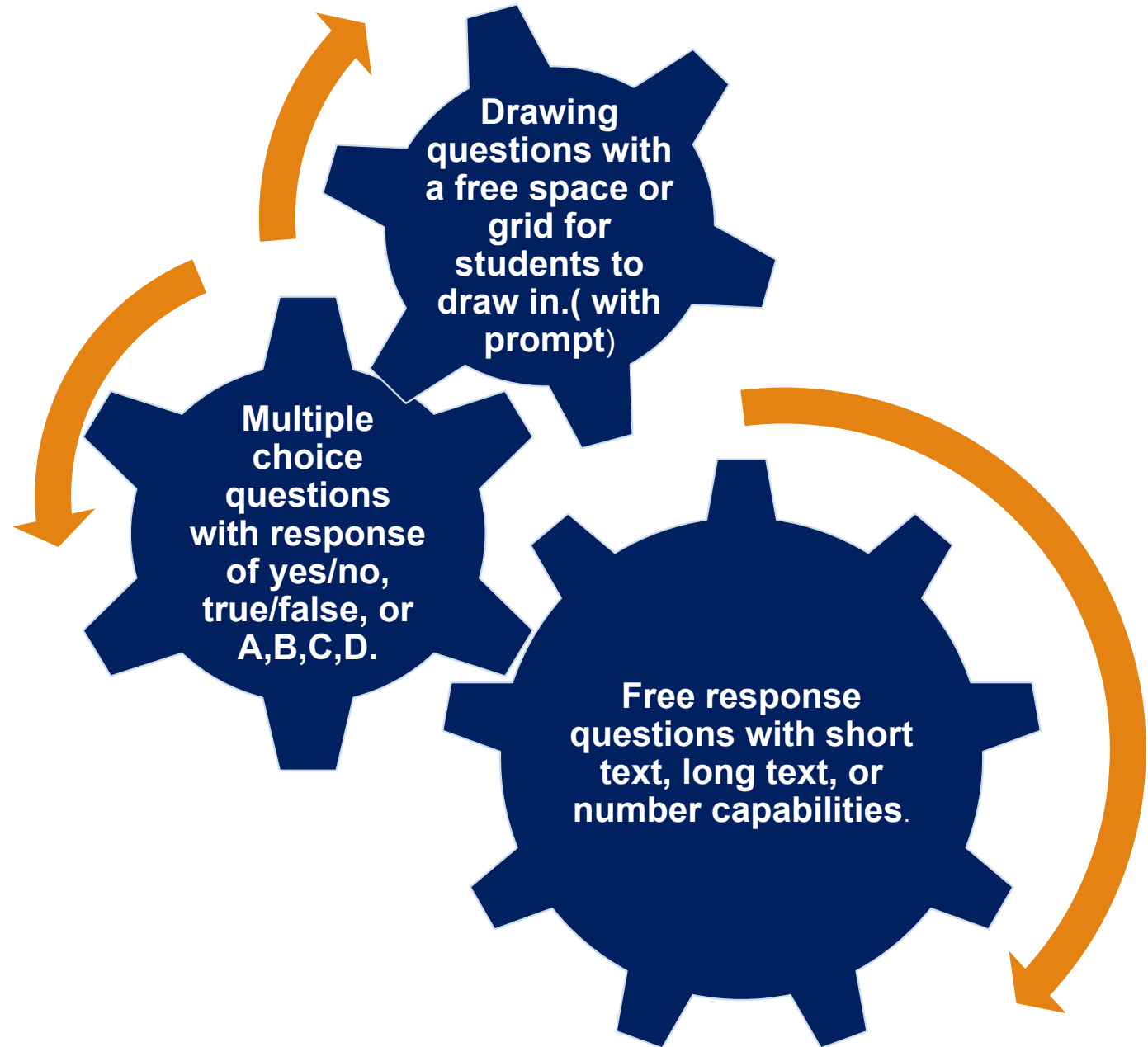
Click Insert > Office Add-ins > Store > Search for Pear Deck > Click Add > Exit

After installing, the Pear Deck icon will appear in the right hand corner of your screen

Click the Pear Deck icon to launch the Sidebar

Pear Deck allows teachers to create slide show style presentations. While building, teachers can pick from these question types:



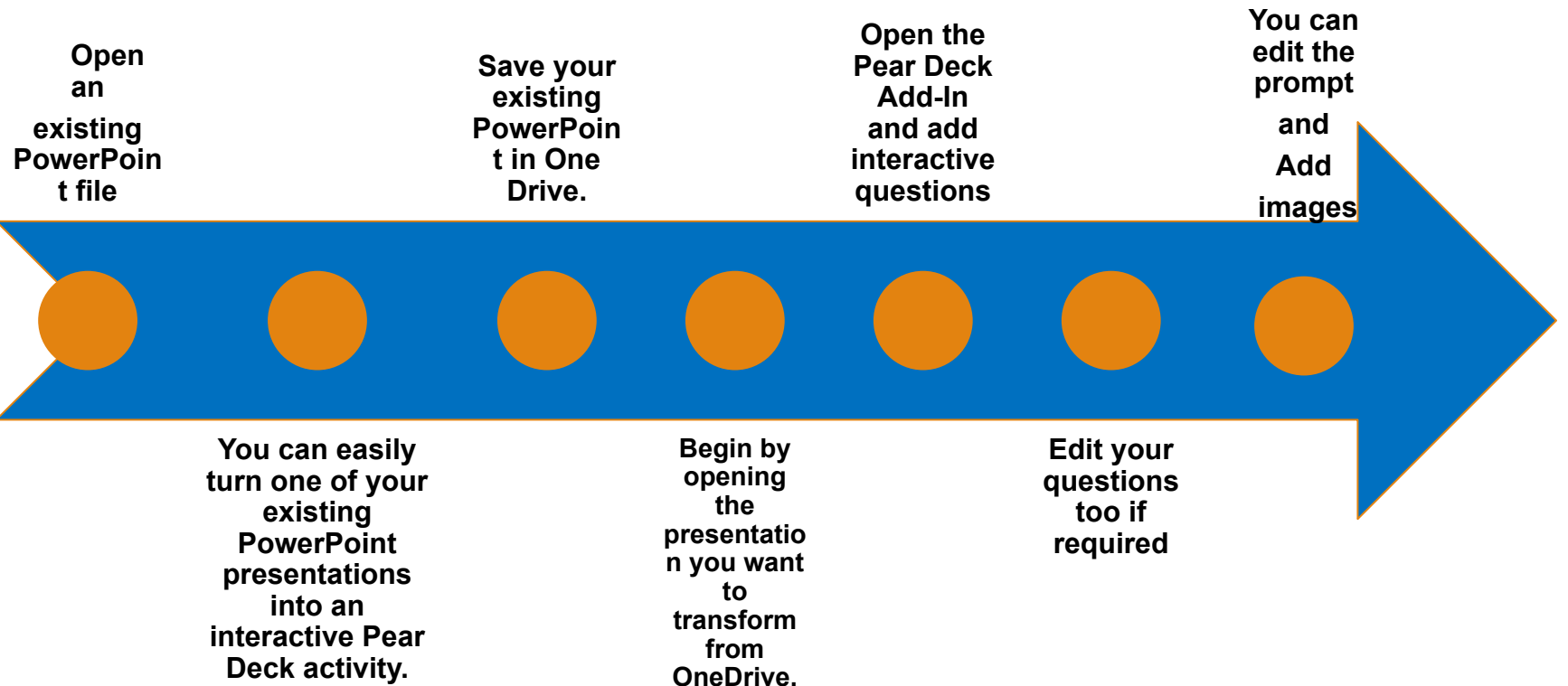

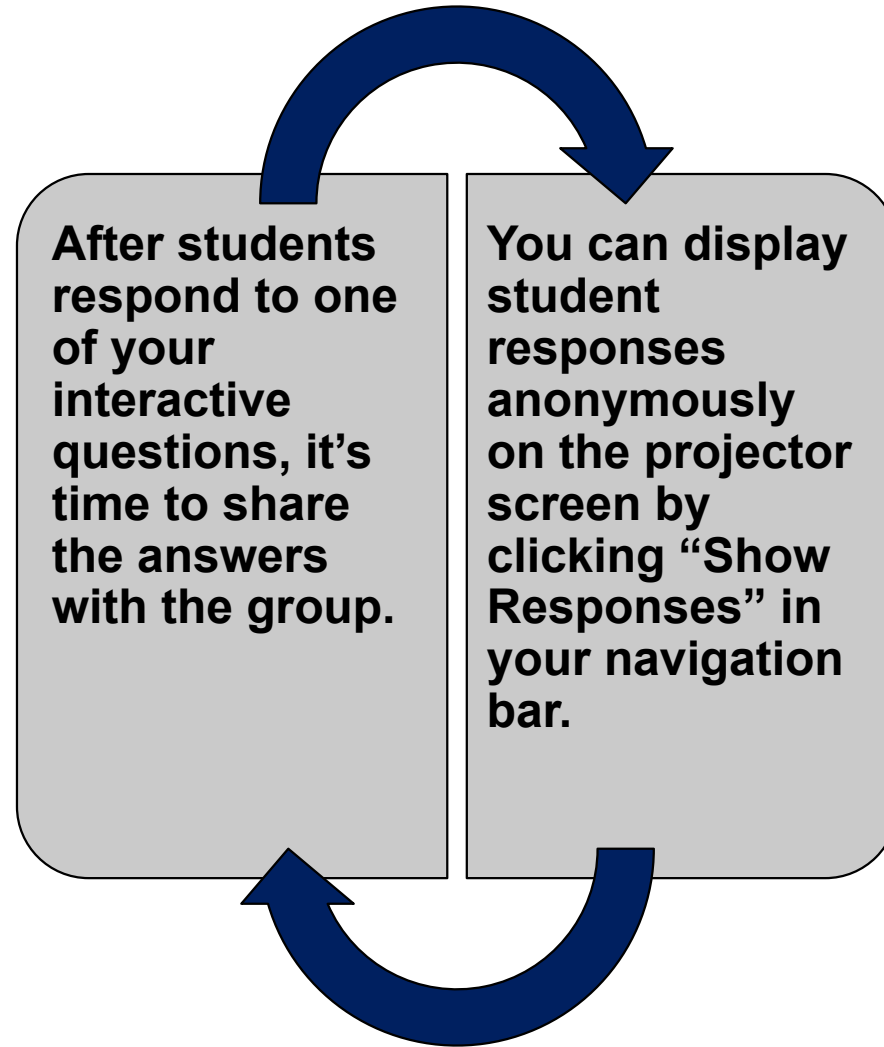
# HOW TO PRESENT WITH PEARDECK



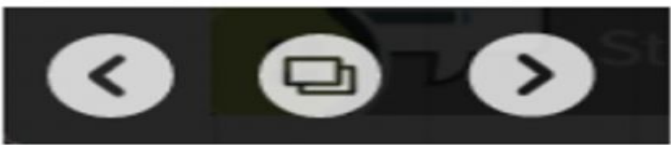
- **Start presenting a session**
- **Once you've created your instructional content and interactive slides, you are ready to present. Connect your computer to your projector. Make sure you have the Pear Deck Add-in open, then click the green button "Present with Pear Deck".**
- **Help students join**
- **When you present with Pear Deck, Join instructions show up automatically on the projector view. To join the presentation students can follow these steps:**
  - **Visit [joinpd.com](https://joinpd.com)**
  - **Sign in with their Office 365 /Google account**
  - **Enter the unique 5 letter code displayed on the projector**
