- Free tool
- Enhances the videos taken from YouTube, Khan Academy, National Geographic, TED or any other source
- Makes the videos interactive and student centered
- The videos can be shared through links , mails or class codes on any learning platform.
- Puts the student in control of the video shared by the teacher

About Edpuzzle



- Helps the students with different learning capabilities to learn at their own pace.
- A student is switched from a passive learner to an active viewer.
- Assessment centered
- Helps the teacher to add the following in between the video:
 - ✓ Multiple Choice Questions
 - ✓ Open Ended Questions
 - ✓ Comments and notes in the form of text or audio
 - ✓ Add his/her own narration

About Edpuzzle




- The data so collected can be analyzed




