Features for Teachers



- Teachers can post assignments and quizzes and grade them
- Teachers can share digital media such as blogs, links, videos, documents, notes, presentations etc.
- Teachers can differentiate instruction by creating subgroups of students




- Teachers can maintain a personal content library and share content with members.
- The calendar keeps all homework organized for teachers and students
- A message board allows secure and open communication that can be monitored and controlled by the teacher.
- Teachers can expand their PLN (Personal Learning Network)

Features for Students and Parents



- Text alerts remind students of assignments/quizzes
- Students can upload homework assignments
- Students can 24/7 access the content stored in "Library"
- Students can only post to the whole group or individually to the teacher.



- Parents and teachers can message one another
- Parents can only see posts created by the teacher and their ward.
- Parents can view their child's grades and calendar events within Edmodo.
- Parents can not view posts made by other students in the group.


Add Parents

It will ask you to enter the parent's email address or mobile number to connect with parents.




Create and Post Assignments I



Select the class to which you wish to post an assignment and click on + sign.

You can attach a file, a link or you can upload it from the library. Click on the assign button.



You can either create a new assignment or load an existing assignment from the library.

Using Edmodo

Create and Post Assignments II



- You can either assign the assignment to the entire class or to few students.
- Also you can schedule your assignment by setting date and time.
- Assignment can also be added to grade book.

Create and Post Assignments III


➤ Once an assignment has been posted students get an alert. They can attach their homework and provide a comment/message with it.

➤ Teacher will also receive an alert in the notifications section any time a student turns in their assignment and can view a list of all submissions.

Using Edmodo Create and Post Quiz I



Select the class to which you wish to post a quiz and click on + sign.

Select the question type from the drop down. You can choose from multiple choice, matching true/false, short answer or fill in the blank.

Create and Post Quiz III



Students can select the "Take Quiz" button to take the quiz.

Students can view their results immediately by clicking "view results". They can review each quiz question and see the correct answers.

Using Edmodo Grade Students



Select the progress tab under classes tab in the top navigation bar.

For any assignment posted to the group, a column will be added in the gradebook. Once a student's assignment has been graded, the grade will automatically populate in the gradebook.



Using Edmodo Assign Badges




You can tick against the name of the student to assign a particular badge to him/her.




Connecting to communities across the Globe



Teachers can build their individual professional learning communities by networking and making new connections through Edmodo.




To connect with a teacher on Edmodo, search the teacher, visit his/her profile page and click the "Connect" button.
