??????

***Plickers** is an assessment tool.

*It is a rapid-response classroom-polling app that lets teachers use one mobile device to scan paper cards for student responses.




Why Plickers ???

- **Easy to use**
- **Engage students**
- **Time saver for teachers**
- **Organises data automatically**



How it works ???

- Each student is given a card with unique visual code.
- Each side represents an answer choice.
- The student holds the card so that the letter they choose to answer is at the top of their card.



-
- The teacher uses the app on the smartphone or tablet to scan the card.
 - The app recognizes the cards, records and captures the answer that the student choose.



Points to be Noted :

- Only the teacher needs the Plicker App. Students don't need to download.
- The letters on the cards are small so fellow students cannot see their selection.
- App will only record each student's answer once.
- Must have wifi connection to project real time data.
