Suma's Java trail

## How can learning of Computer Programming (Java) be turned into a delightful experience for students?

Achieving a celebrity status does not happen often and not particularly in the teaching profession. Suma's innovative strategies for making Computer Programming joyful and the excellent results thereafter, however, caught the interest of the news daily The New Indian Express and TV news about Suma's work. An important milestone for Suma's career indeed.

This was the first time in 15 years of teaching life that Suma had the opportunity to do an action research project and be able to reflect and improve upon her teaching. This has been a high point in Suma's career when she felt very valued by the entire school community - Principal, parents, colleagues and the students.

**Problem**

As a computer science teacher, Suma had to teach Java Programming language to the senior secondary students who find it very challenging and difficult to comprehend. The situation is even worse for the students of advanced Process (IT). These students are from the Government stream and have opted for IT instead of Maths. Most of these students are average or below average in their logical thinking, which is critical for working any Computer Programming language. In the first semester/term she provided an academic year 4 out of Suma's 11 students failed miserably and the ones who managed to pass had low scores. Suma has observed this phenomenon for the past 12 years and didn't have second thoughts about what her topic for action research should be.

**Outcome**

Instead of the traditional lecturing method which was teacher centred, Suma moved on to actively engaged student centred teaching practice. This approach enabled students to have a positive attitude for learning programming. They successfully handled programming assignments and stopped looking at Java as a nightmare. Suma modified her teaching methodology to bring a closer, bidirectional learning style of the inquiry of the students. They were learning Java Programming through activities of their preferred learning style: visual, auditory or kinesthetic and hence had better comprehension of the concepts leading to better results in the examinations.

**Intervention**


Suma researched various innovative methods for teaching programming and shared her findings with her coaches including her own Principal, a couple of colleagues, Head Examiners of IT of CBSE, KERALA, and through a collaborative approach with them, developed methodologies to teach terminologies, the variables, selection statements, iteration constructs, functions, classes, etc. Suma used the role play technique to demonstrate the difference between the selection statements 'if' and 'switch'. Debates were held to find the ideal loop statement for solving various programs. Simple teaching aids like boxes were used to represent memory locations depicting variables and square pieces of chart papers to teach sorting techniques in arrays.

Suma is confident that her action research will be useful for her partner school as well.

The ICT curriculum for the UK schools will be revamped with new focus on teaching Computer Programming. I can foresee a lot of frustrated students who will find it challenging to come to grips with the principles of programming. The innovative teaching methods I have developed for my action research will hopefully help these students and their Computer Science faculty.
