











Month-wise PM eVidya IVRS Calls Status





## Strategies for implementation

- SOP & Guidelines for developing engaging eContent developed & shared
- 200 channels are up (BETA RUN): midnight, 7 June, 2023.
- 2 Orientations & 7 Phase Trainings done (258 participants from 34 States/UTs and 4 Autonomous Bodies), Online Training of 700 People
- Two meetings of AAC have been held
- Dipstick Survey initiated
- meetings with States/UTs for sharing video contents.

## Allocation of 200 PM eVIDYA DTH TV Channels to States/UTs/Institutions/ Autonomous Bodies

### Criteria for allocation:

1. Language/Medium of Instruction
2. Population
3. Geographical Location
4. Board (i.e., curricular framework, textbooks etc.)
5. Number of Schools
6. Number and Variety of Textbooks
7. eContent Readiness
8. Technical Feasibilities
9. Willingness of the states/UTs
